

## **FIEP'S COMMON DECLARATION**

Taking into consideration that the objective of the Common Declarations, signed by the Commanders and General Directors from 1994 to 2004, consists of strengthening the relationships among their institutions, noting the conclusions and recommendations of the Commissions included in the FIEP Statutes attached hereinafter,

**ARE PLEASED TO WELCOME**

The Argentinian National Gendarmerie and the Chilean Carabineros as associated members of FIEP.

**ACCEPT**

The FIEP Commissions working timetable for 2006 under the Italian Presidency included in the attached document.

**CONSIDER THAT**

Given the fact that the Council of Europe relates directly to the Member States, it is deemed as not possible to transform FIEP into a Consultative Organ of the Council, since it is an intergovernmental association, but highlight the convenience of FIEP members participating in seminars on police issues and working groups of the Council of Europe, in order to promote the Police Forces and Gendarmeries with military Status model.

**AGREE THAT**

Under the Presidency of the Italian Carabinieri, a delegation should be designated to visit the Internal Troops of Azerbaijan, due to their request for accession to FIEP, after the presentation of their Institution to FIEP during the last meeting of the Logistics and New Technologies Commission held in Romania, according to article 14 of the FIEP Statutes.

## **APPROVE**

Fostering the exchange of operational experiences among FIEP members, establishing a network of points of contact and promoting courses focused on the fight against terrorism, given concern over the increase in the number of international terrorist acts.

## **REAFFIRM**

The interest to coordinate their action within the framework of the European Security and Defence Policy (ESDP) in order to consolidate, as often as possible, FIEP members common positions, and decide, in this aim, to establish a network of ESDP points of contact.


## **STATE THAT**

It would be convenient to give some thought to the future of the Association, given that the creation of a common doctrine of the members would facilitate a better understanding of the Association abroad, emphasizing the specific contributions of the Police Forces with military Status to citizen safety. For this reason, the Organization and Service Commission 2006 will continue to elaborate the FIEP doctrine.


The present Common Statement is signed in ten copies in Madrid, on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2005.






